HOUSE COCKTAILS

- 2016 **Cotes du Gasogne**, Plaimont Producers, France 7 / 25
Situating in the heart of South-West France, the Plaimont vineyards stretch from the foothills of the Pyrenees to the hills and valleys of Gascony. Clean and dry with aromatics of pineapple, peach and pear.
- 2016 **Grillo**, Enologica Cassara, Sicily, Italy 8 / 28
A biodynamic producer with hilly vineyards in the West of Sicily. This Grillo is typical of the area, rich tropical fruit with a floral notes.
- 2016 **Ariusios Greek Island Assrytko**, Chios, Greece 9.5 / 35
Hailing from Chios on the far eastern side of Greece. Assrytko is making some of the most exciting wine coming out of Greece at the moment. Lemon fresh acidity with a seaside minerality, hints of green olive and wild herbs.
- 2016 **La Distesa**, Marche Bianco, Terre Silvate, Italy 10 / 40
From a tiny organic farm in Le Marche, winemaker Corrado makes his Verdicchio the old fashioned way. A savoury, nutty white wine that is incredibly versatile.
- 2013 **I Clivi**, Brazan, Collio, Friuli, Italy 50
‘I Clivi means ‘the slopes’ and this Fruilano, from a father and son team who have been working organically from the early 90’s, comes from a ninety year old vineyard planted on a particularly steep slope. This a complex, elegant white wine with a gentle, floral aroma and wonderful texture.
- 2016 **Nino Barraco**, Cataratto, Marsala, Sicily 55
A wine that comes from the very west of Sicily, from a beautiful organic vineyard just a few metres from the sea. The black volcanic soils lend a beautiful smokiness to this salty, citrusy wine that has a natural affinity with seafood.
- 2015 **La Grapperie**, La Pressoir de Saint Pierre, Loire, France 65
Chenin Blanc from an organic vineyard over 100 years old in the north of the Loire. This is a dry, mineral and savoury, with an almost stony character.
- 2016 **Frederic Cossard**, Beaune ‘Les Bressandes’, Burgundy 85
This has everything we love about Burgundy, from one of the regions up and coming stars, Frederic Cossard. Fruit and minerality, power and poise, this has it all.

 **The Royal Jam – 12** 
Celebrating the British-American union of Harry and Megan, we have created the Royal Jam, inspired by the American classic PB&J, and using Uncle Duke’s Whisky, a Scottish whisky aged in American Oak Uncle Duke’s Whisky, Chambord, peanut butter, lemon

ORANGE WINE

2013 **Skerji**, Vitovska, Carso, Friuli, Italy 65
A beautiful expression of amber wine. Made with the local Vitovska grape grown on one of Italy’s greatest terroirs, a limestone plateau just a few kilometres from the Adriatic. It pairs ripe fruit with wonderful minerality. A complex, beautiful wine.

ROSE WINE

2016 **Provence**, Chateau Nestuby, France 9 / 24
Perfect light Provence salmon pink served in the classically shaped bottle of the region. Aromas of candied strawberries and Mediterranean herbs.

RED WINE

- 2016 **Cotes de Gasogne**, Plaimont Producers, France 7 / 25
The Cotes de Gasogne appellation covers the fantastically exposed hillsides between the Pyrenees and the Atlantic. Alongside the rich terroir the tannat grape gives the wine its structure of black fruit whilst the Cabernet Sauvignon gives it freshness and spicy hints.
- 2015 **Nero d’Avola**, Terra Firma, Sicily, Italy 8 / 28
Nero d’Avola makes big styles of wine often akin to Syrah. Packed full of sun drenched Sicilian fruit and sweetly scented with dark cherry earthiness intertwined with dried spice and vanilla.
- 2016 **Elias Mora**, ‘Semi Crianza’, Toro, Spain 9.5 / 35
The Elias Mora winery situated in Toro in North East Spain produces traditional Spanish wine through native vines. Made from Tinta de Toro the grandfather of Tempranillo and aged in American oak this brings a welcome hit of black fruit, liquorice, coffee and vanilla.
- 2015 **Cristiano Guttarolo**, Miro, Puglia, Italy 10 / 40
Primitivo, but not as we know it. From one of the highest sites in Puglia, Cristiano’s wild vineyard produces a wine of unusual freshness and perfumed vibrancy.
- 2015 **Jerome Lambert**, Le Fil Rouge, Anjou, Loire, France 50
Jerome Lambert is a truly underground winemaker, making tiny quantities of exquisite wine in France’s Loire Valley. This blend of Groulleau and Cabernet Franc is typical of the region’s reds – light, juicy, earthy and spiced.
- 2015 **Testalonga**, Rossese di Dolceacqua, Liguria, Italy 55
Winemaker Antonio Perrino has been making wine in his garage in the village of Dolceacqua for over fifty vintages! From a tiny plot of vines in the hills of Liguria over 100 years old, this is a wine which tastes distinctly Mediterranean, full of sun kissed fruit and heady with herbs.
- 2015 **Podere Santa Maria**, Rosso di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy 65
From the deft hands of winemaker Marino Colleoni, this incredible Sangiovese comes from one of the highest vineyards in Montalcino. A wine of remarkable elegance.
- 2014 **Olek Bondonio**, Barbaresco ‘Roncagliette’, Piedmont, Italy 85
Olek Bondonio is one of the best young winemakers in Piedmont today and this Nebbiolo, from one of the most storied vineyards in the region is clear evidence why. This is the complete package, a wine that walks that tightrope balance of power and poise that suggests it won’t be long before Olek reaches the heady heights of his neighbour and friend Angelo Gaja.

SWEET WINE

2013 **Ezio Cerruti**, Sol, Langhe, Piedmont (375ml) 15 / 55
A beautiful passito of Moscato from one of the masters of the style that spends four years in barrel before release. Ezio’s patience in both the vineyard and cellar yields a wine of unusual complexity, bright, golden and floral, its sweetness is tempered by vibrant acidity, spice and a savoury minerality from chalky soils.
